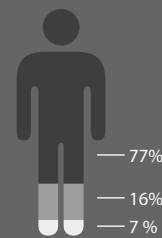

ORGANIZATION TYPE



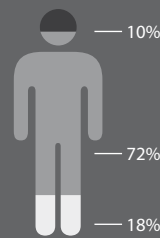
